- 1.** Bidders must submit the TAX compliance verification pin on a SARS letterhead. **2.** In the case of the Joint venture, Tax compliance verification pins of all parties must be attached. **3.** Copy of JV agreement (in case of JV) must be attached. **4.** Supply municipal services (water, sanitation, rates and electricity) clearance certificate or Lease Agreement with a current Bill and rates clearances, or Current Bill of Account not owing more than 90 days. In a case where the services are paid by the Landlord, the signed lease agreement and statement of account must be submitted by the bidder. **5.** All supplementary / compulsory MBD forms contained in the bid document must be completed and signed in full. **6.** Failure to comply with point 5 will invalidate your bid. **7.** Bidders must attach an Original BBEE Verification Certificate or a Valid Copy of BBEE Verification Certificate, in case of Joint Venture bidders must submit consolidated BBEE certificate. **8.** Bidders must be registered on the National Treasury Centralized Suppliers Database and must submit their registration summary report. **9.
