### **EVALUATION CRITERIA**

**Registration with the below professional body will not be applicable:**

- Registration with the “Project Management Professional”
- Registration with the Association of South African Quantity Surveyors (**ASAQS**)

**The Evaluation Criteria will be amended as follows:**

- **Project Leader** – “Must have successfully managed similar projects with 10 years’ experience in Electrical construction projects, Project Management Degree and registered with **SACPCMP** – South African Council for the Project and Construction Management Profession” **This will be applicable to all four (4) profession categories.**


- **Criterion 5.4.2 – Quantity Surveyor** - *Must have successfully managed similar projects, 10 years of experience in quantity surveying projects, BSc / B.Tech in Quantity Surveying and Registration with (SACQSP) - South African Council for the Quantity Surveying Profession.*

The erratum is in line with section 217 of The Constitution which states “***that an organ of state must contract for goods or services in accordance with a procurement system which is fair, equitable, transparent, competitive, and cost effective***” and ***MFMA Circular 110 – “Unfair Criteria used in bidding processes relating to infrastructure procurement”***
