

60-DAY GENERAL AMNESTY

ON METER TAMPERING, ILLEGAL CONNECTIONS AND UNAUTHORISED METER SHIFTS.

CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd commenced a 60-day General Amnesty on meter tampering, illegal connections and unauthorised meter shifts. This initiative invites consumers who have engaged in meter tampering, illegal connections, or unauthorised shifting of meter boxes to voluntarily disclose so as to normalise their status without facing the standard punitive penalties or prosecution.

THE TERMS OF THE AMNESTY INCLUDE:

Waiver of Penalties: Consumers who voluntarily disclose meter tampering or illegal connections during the amnesty period would qualify for full waiver of tampering of fines and back-dated billing penalties (or subjected to a significantly reduced flat fee).

Free Normalisation: CENTLEC teams will normalise the connection and seal the meter.

No Prosecution: Participants will be guaranteed immunity from criminal prosecution for past theft of electricity, provided they sign an acknowledgement of debt for future usage.

PARTICULARS NEEDED FROM THE CUSTOMER:

- Proof of Home Ownership (Title Deed).
- Identity Document.
- Quotation of Electricity Bill.
- 5-Day waiting period if meter box is tampered with.
